This not preclude or substitute any action on the part of the FEI subsequent to mention of late or unadvised withdrawals in the Foreign Judge's report.

2. GROOMS

Requests for accommodation must be sent with entries.

A sufficient number of WCs and shower, with hot and cold water, will be available. The OC will not be responsible for any travelling or living expense. Only those grooms who have given their names to O.C. will be authorized to remain within the FEI stable area during the night.

OCs must provide sufficient sanitary and showering facilities, with hot and cold water for male and female grooms. These must be regularly maintained in a proper state of cleanliness.

3. HORSES / PONIES

The OC will not be responsible for any travelling or feeding expense. Horses must be stabled in the boxes assigned to them on the show ground. Horses may not be unloaded on their arrival without the authorisation of the stable Manager.

Arrivals time : Wednesday 2 July 2008 – 3.00 p.m. to 7.00 p.m.

Thursday 3 July 2008 – 8.30 a.m. to 5.00 p.m. Stables will be allocated on arrival. Stables must be mucked out daily and dirty bedding and rubbish placed in special containers. All horses will be bedded on shavings. Further supplies will be provided daily according to instruction and price available on arrival (shavings € 9 – hay € 8 per bale). Horses must be stabled within the FEI stable area for the duration of the event. The stables will be closed between 11.00 p.m. and 6.30 a.m. Horses may not leave their boxes without the official show starting number.

4. WELCOME

The participants will meet all repatriation cost following any accidents. Through their entry in the competition, the participants accept that the OC cannot be held responsible for any accidents during the jumping events, and before or after these.

THE FEI CODE OF CONDUCT

FOR THE WELFARE OF THE HORSE

The Fédération Equestre Internationale (FEI) expects all those involved in international equestrian sport to adhere to the FEI's Code of Conduct and to acknowledge and accept that at all times the welfare of the horse must be paramount and must never be subordinated to competitive or commercial influences.

1. At all stages during the preparation and training of competition horses, welfare must take precedence over all other demands. This includes good horse management, training methods, farriery and tack, and transportation.
2. Horses and competitors must be fit, competent and in good health before they are allowed to compete. This encompasses medication use, surgical procedures that threaten welfare or safety, pregnancy in mares and the misuse of aids.
3. Events must not prejudice horse welfare. This involves paying careful attention to the competition areas, ground surfaces, weather conditions, stabling, site safety and fitness of the horse for onward travel after the event.
4. Every effort must be made to ensure that horses receive proper attention after they have competed and that they are treated humanely when their competition careers are over. This covers proper veterinary care, competition injuries, euthanasia and retirement.
5. **The FEI urges all involved with the sport to attain the highest levels of education in their areas of expertise.**
